Q FEVER VIRUS SEROLOGY (IGM & IGG) (COXIELLA BURNETII INFECTION)

Specimen required: **Serum (1 x SST)** (Done in house for pre-vaccination testing only)
Department: Referred test
Symptoms: May include fever, headache, rash, myalgia, arthralgia, malaise, pneumonia, hepatomegaly and hepatitis.
Note: Consider also mycoplasma, EBV, CMV and Toxoplasmosis.
Patient must also have pre-vaccination skin test for Q Fever.

QUANTIFERON TEST

See WHOLE BLOOD INTERFERON GAMMA ASSAY Can Only be performed at Main laboratory Monday to Thursday

QUINIDINE

Specimen required: **Serum (1 x SST)**
Department: Referred test
Reference range: As stated on report
Peak Level: Rapid release, 1 - 3 hours.
Slow or sustained release > 3 hours.
Half Life: 6 - 7 hours.
Note: Sample should be taken just prior to the next dose.
Please note time of last dose and collection.

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
