



Questionnaire & Instructions for Semen Collection

- 1. Collect the sample between two to five days after last ejaculation.**
- Masturbation without the use of lubricant is the preferred method of collection. Samples collected using condoms that are non-latex, contain no spermicide or lubricants, are acceptable.
- 3. If collected in a condom, the patient must transfer the sample into the jar provided. The lab will not accept condoms.**
- Wash your hands and collect the entire sample into the jar provided. The collection containers are either opaque and white capped, or clear and yellow capped.
- Label the container with full name, DOB, date and time of collection.
- Keep the sample at body temperature or at room temperature, if possible. DO NOT expose sample to extreme temperatures.
