

Questionnaire & Instructions for Semen Collection

1. **Collect the sample between 2-5 days after last ejaculation.**
2. Masturbation without lubricant use is the preferred collection method. Samples collected via condoms are acceptable, provided they are non-latex and non-spermicidal.
3. **The lab will not accept condoms. All condom-collected samples must be transferred into the jar provided.**
4. Wash your hands and collect the entire sample into the jar provided. The collection containers are either opaque and white capped, or clear and yellow capped.
5. Label the container with full name, DOB, date and time of collection.
6. Keep the sample at body temperature or at room temperature, if possible. DO NOT expose sample to extreme temperatures.
