

# Questionnaire & Instructions for Semen Collection

- 1. Collect the sample between two to five days after last ejaculation.**
- Masturbation without the use of lubricant is the preferred method of sample collection. If necessary, samples collected using condoms that are non-latex, contain no spermicide or lubricant are acceptable. These can be sourced from pharmacies.
- 3. The patient must transfer the sample to a jar if collected in a condom. The lab will not accept condoms.**
- Wash your hands and collect the entire sample into the jar provided. The containers for collection are either opaque and white capped, or clear and yellow capped.
- Label the container with full name, date of birth, date and time of collection.
- Keep the sample at body temperature by placing inside your jacket or jumper, or at room temperature, if this is possible. DO NOT expose the sample to any extreme temperatures, eg. car air-con/heaters
- 7. Samples for Fertility must be delivered to one of our Laboratories within one hour of collection.** Post vasectomy samples must be delivered to the laboratory as soon as possible (within one hour if possible).
